## **Proposed Rate Changes**

Effective With Meter Readings On and After March 1, 2017

- 1. For <u>ALL</u> rates the Energy Efficiency Fund charge of \$0.0009/kWh has been incorporated into the Distribution Delivery Service kWh charge. (no change)
- 2. For <u>ALL</u> rate the Distribution Delivery Service kWh charge has been <u>increased</u> by \$0.002/kWh. (increase of \$2.00 per 1,000 kWh)
- 3. For <u>ALL</u> rates the Power Cost Adjustment has been <u>reduced</u> from \$0.02400 to \$0.01600. (decrease of \$8.00 per 1,000 kWh)
- 4. For <u>ALL</u> rates the Transmission, Ancillary and Energy Supply charges have been combined into one kWh and/or kW charge. (no change)

This is a net <u>decrease</u> for <u>ALL</u> rates/members.

For a residential members using 1,000 kWh per month the changes will result in an overall decrease of \$6.00
